#### Nurserv

Children born on or between 2 July 2020 and 1 July 2021 (inclusive) or who come under the deferral circumstances, are eligible for a place in our nursery unit.

#### **P1**

Any child whose fourth birthday falls on or before 1 July 2024 will have reached compulsory school age in September 2024. Children who are currently in our nursery or the playgroup will need to apply for a place.

If your child is starting <u>pre-school</u> or <u>primary</u> school in September 2024, you can apply for their place online from **Tuesday 9 January 2024 at 12 noon.** 

The closing date and time for pre-school and primary one applications will be 12 noon on Friday 26 January 2024.
