

If your child is starting pre-school or primary school in September 2024, you can apply for their place online from **Tuesday 9 January 2024 at 12 noon.**

The closing date and time for pre-school and primary one applications is 12 noon on Friday 26 January 2024.

Please ensure you have the forms submitted on time including birth certificates and verification evidence. Forms submitted after this date must be treated as 'late' and should we have more applications than places available 'late' applications cannot be considered until all 'on time' applications have been offered a place.

A new After school's opportunity

An opportunity for pupils in Year 5-7 is being planned for after school. Robert Snodgrass, a longstanding multi-skills coach, is offering 30 places for the first 30 names and payments lodged with school for an afterschool's programme of physical coaching and exercise which has a focus on game skills and team activities.

The programme commences on Tuesday 16^{th} January from 3-4pm at a cost of £2 per session. This will run on a trial basis for 6 weeks, until the end of February. The cost for the 6 weeks is £12 per pupil.
