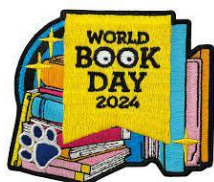

School Car Park – Health and Safety

Can I remind you to follow these simple but effective guidelines when using the school car park:

As we only have one entrance in, and one entrance out, the flow of cars moving around the car park is extremely important. To this end, PLEASE DO NOT stop your car on the roadway thus blocking the flow of traffic. This impacts all drivers and ultimately the collection of pupils.

Attendance
