### **Tickets**

- Once you have purchased your tickets online, your tickets will be emailed to you. Please print them at home or show on mobile device. Tickets will not be seat allocated, when you arrive on the day, you can choose your seat.
- Showings as follows:
  - Monday 16<sup>th</sup> December doors open at 12.30pm, show at 1pm
  - Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> December doors open at 5.45pm, with instrumentalist from 6pm and show at 6.30pm. This showing will be recorded.
  - Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> December doors open at 6.00pm, show at 6.30pm

Please note that our instrumentalists will play before the pantomime on Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> December. The pantomime will also be professionally recorded on Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup>. Digital downloads of the recording will be available to purchase after the showings.

#### **Timetable changes**

**Nursery** children will start school on Monday 16<sup>th</sup> at 11.30am until 3pm. They will attend as normal every other day.

**Primary** children will go home at 1.15pm on Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> and Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> to allow time to return to school for 6pm on both evenings. Mrs. Simpson's Musicians will be required at 5.30pm on Tuesday only.

## **Nursery**

Children born on or between 2 July 2021 and 1 July 2022 (inclusive) or who come under the deferral circumstances, are eligible for a place in our nursery unit.

### Year 1

Any child whose fourth birthday falls on or before 1 July 2025 will have reached compulsory school age in September 2025. Children who are currently in our nursery or the playgroup will need to apply for a place.

EA will publish admissions criteria on the 5<sup>th</sup> December 2024.

If your child is starting <u>pre-school</u> or <u>primary</u> school in September 2025, you can apply for their place online from **Friday 10th January 2025 at 12 noon.** 

The closing date and time for pre-school and primary one applications will be 12 noon on Friday 24th January 2025.
